MAIN AIM

To encourage you to use Erasmus+ within your contexts and increase the participation of young people in international youth work through the Erasmus+.

- Increase the participation of young people from disadvantaged areas in E+:Youth in Action Programme;
- Develop new partnerships and projects among the participating organizations;
- Increase competences of participants to better understand core principles of developing quality inclusion projects involving specific target groups.

- The participants should:
- know the E+: Youth in Action Programme and its priorities;
- Work actively with young people and be able to involve them;
- Know how to support non-formal education learning process;
- Know the basics of project management;
- Be interested and motivated to build partnerships and develop a project idea;
- Be able to work in English.

Youth workers and Youth leaders with active roles in organisations coming from disadvantaged areas with the profile above mentioned and that have preferably attended or are willing to attend the prior national information & training sessions linked to this activity.
