County Council employees were deployed to various parts of Kilkenny. A phone/email link/telly/weather conference centre was set up with the County Council, Weather and Fire Services. Risk Assessments are to be done before workers go out to Emergencies. 24 Staff were sent out to Castlecomer and Piltown areas. The Defence Forces helped and Civil defence as well.

A report was given by Seamus Kavanagh A/SE about the amounts of money to be spent on various parts of the County, on roads public and private, drainage Total €21,349,440. We got a detailed report about what it was spent on.
