

## SUMMER EMPLOYMENT SCHEME - FOR THIRD LEVEL STUDENTS

Kilkenny County Council will be operating a Summer Employment Scheme for Third Level students between May and September 2018. It is intended to employ a number of students to carry out environmental works in Kilkenny City & Environs. The periods of employment are:

- (a) 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018
- (b) 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2018 to 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2018
- (c) 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 to 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2018

Successful candidates must have a current Safe Pass Card. Personal Protection Clothing will be supplied. Appropriate Health & Safety training will be given.

**Hours:** Variable hours, Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m.  
It may be necessary that one Sunday be worked from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

**Rate of Pay:** €9.55 per hour.

## TEMPORARY LIFEGUARDS – SUMMER 2018

Kilkenny County Council is currently recruiting Lifeguards for the Summer Season 2018 to provide lifeguard cover on the River Nore & River Barrow. Applications are sought from suitably qualified persons, for the above posts. A panel of successful candidates will be formed from which appointments will be made where and when required.

Candidates should not be less than 17 years at 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018 and have, as a minimum, a current Irish Water Safety Inland Open Waterway or Beach Lifeguard Qualification or have achieved this by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018, or equivalent qualification as recognised by International Lifesaving Federation (ILS). All candidates will be required to undergo a practical test in BLS, swimming ability, lifesaving technique and theory test conducted by an Irish Water Safety Examiner and also attend for interview.

Successful candidates will be required to actively monitor and observe members of the public in their lifeguard patrol area. They will be required to maintain a daily training routine.

Lifeguards will be required to work irregular hours including work at weekends **and particularly over holiday weekends.** The recruitment of successful candidates will be subject to receipt of satisfactory Garda Vetting Report.

Kilkenny County Council reserves the right to shortlist candidates having regard to education, qualifications and experience.
