

Eurovision Special Update

Momentum is gathering pace now with two weeks left as the **Acorn Club** will host **EUROVISION SPECIAL SHOW** in Freshford on Thursday 15th November 2018 with a host of stars including Niamh Kavanagh - Paul Harrington - Charlie McGettigan, with guests Kate Cullen, Lorraine Maher and The Deirdre Maher School of Dancing performing a tribute to Riverdance. Accompanying will be an 11 piece concert Orchestra and Chorus. The compare for the evening will be Mary Kennedy (RTE's Nationwide programme). Musical direction will be provided by Ollie Hennessy (RTE Rose of Tralee). Besides singing their classic Eurovision songs each artist will also present their own individual programme of songs on the night. It should be a great night's entertainment.

This will be the first year that the Acorn Club will stage their show outside of the Community Hall and this year the show will be held in St Lachtain's Catholic Church. This is due to the amount of space required to hold a large Orchestra and Chorus, sound and lighting and an anticipated larger audience is expected to attend.
